How to use TachoSil®

Open procedures



1. Open aluminium blister The cover film can be removed outside the sterile zone.



4. Trim (optional)

Important: TachoSil® should extend 1—2 cm beyond the edge of the wound.



7. Press in place Press in place slightly for at least 3–5 minutes, ideally with a moist compress.



2. Open plastic blister Peel off the cover film in the sterile zone with sterile gloves.



5. Moisten (optional)

If the wound is dry, moistening before application is recommended. If the wound is wet, TachoSil® can be dry when applied.



8. Remove the compress Remove carefully, using forceps if necessary.



3. Grasp Remove the patch from the sterile packaging with forceps.



6. Apply

Apply with the yellow active side facing the wound. If multiple patches are used, overlap them like roof tiles.

Supplied, ready to use, in sterile packaging, **Indication:** In adults for supportive treatment in surgery for improvement of homestasis, to promote tissue sealing, for suture support in vascular surgery where standard techniques are restricted to experienced surgeons. The quantity of sealant matrices to be used is governed by the size of wound area, and the underlying clinical need for the patient. Application of TachoSil must be natividualised by the treating surgery, use of the smaller size matrices (4.8 cm x 4.2 cm 30 cm x 4.3 cm). In minimally invasive surgery, use of the smaller size matrices (4.8 cm x 4.2 cm x 2.5 cm or pre-rolled 4.8 cm x 4.8 cm) is recommended. Matrices should be used under sterile conditions and used immediately ther opening the inner sterile cover. Prior to application, the wound area should be cleansed, eg. from blood, disinfectants and other fluids. The matrix should be pre-noilstened in saline solution and applied immediately. The yellow, active side of the matrix is applied to the bleeding/leaking surface and held against it with a gantle pressure for 3-5 minutes. Pre-rolled TachoSil® cnn be used for both open surgery and in can pass through a 10 mm or larger port or trocar.
